

## **DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, Hurricane Florence is expected to make landfall in eastern North Carolina and inflict damage across the state beginning on or about Thursday, September 13, and may cause severe flooding and wind damage in Forsyth County; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of the above-described disaster, I have determined that there is an imminent threat of, or existing conditions have caused or will cause, widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property, and public safety authorities may be unable to maintain public order or afford adequate protection for lives or property; and

**WHEREAS**, declaring a State of Emergency and imposing the restrictions and prohibitions ordered herein is necessary to maintain order and protect public health, safety, and welfare, and to secure property.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to the authority vested in me as the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners under Article 1A of Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes and Section 15-2 of the Forsyth County Code of Ordinances:

**Section 1.** A State of Emergency is hereby declared within the jurisdiction of Forsyth County.


**Section 2.** The emergency area covered by this state of emergency shall be the unincorporated areas of Forsyth County.

**Section 3.** I hereby order all Forsyth County law enforcement officers and employees and all other emergency management personnel subject to our control to cooperate in the enforcement and implementation of the provisions of this Declaration, all applicable local ordinances, state and federal laws, and the Forsyth County Emergency Operations Plan.

**Section 4.** I hereby order this declaration: (a) to be distributed to the news media and other organizations calculated to bring its contents to the attention of the general public; (b) to be filed with Clerk to the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners and (c) to be distributed to others as necessary to ensure proper implementation of this declaration.


**Section 5.** This declaration shall take effect on Thursday, September 13, 2018, at 8:00 am and shall remain in effect until modified or rescinded.
