

**CONSENT TO APPLICATION OF COUNTY STATE OF EMERGENCY
DECLARATION**

WHEREAS, Hurricane Florence will be impacting North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the above-described disaster, I have determined that there is an imminent threat of, or existing conditions have caused or will cause, widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property, and public safety authorities will be unable to maintain public order or afford adequate protection for lives or property; and

WHEREAS, the County of Forsyth has declared a state of emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Tobaccoville is located within the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as the Mayor of The Village of Tobaccoville under Article 1A of Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes.


Section 1. Pursuant to N.C.G.S. 166A-19.22(b)(2), the state of emergency declaration issued by the County of Forsyth shall apply within the corporate limits of the Village of Tobaccoville.

Section 2. Emergency restrictions and prohibitions imposed pursuant to the County's state of emergency declaration shall apply with the Village of Tobaccoville unless otherwise declared by an authorized municipal official on behalf of the Village of Tobaccoville.


Section 3. The application of the County's state of emergency declaration within the corporate limits of the Village of Tobaccoville shall remain in effect until further notice.
