## OATH OF OFFICE - MAYOR OF TOBACCOVILLE

## **CALL TO ORDER**

After a short break, Mayor Baker called the meeting to order. Mayor Pro Tem Myron Marion gave the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance. - 1. Dr. Ken Bradstock 3594 Tobaccoville Road. Dr. Bradstock is a 40-year resident of Tobaccoville and a retired Hospice chaplain.
- 2. Darrell Rogers 3270 Spainhour-Mill Road. Mr. Rogers is a 15-year resident of Tobaccoville and has been self-employed for 23 years.
- 3. Boyce Shore 3650 Rolling Hill Drive. Mr. Shore is a life-long resident of Tobaccoville and is a self-employed photographer and educator at Woodland Christian School.
- 4. Steve Wood -8098 Reynolda Road, Pfafftown. Mr. Wood's family moved to the area in 1955, and he has been retired for 11 years.

After all the candidates were interviewed, Mayor Baker announced that a decision will be made at the February 2, 2017 Council meeting in order to allow Council Member McGee to participate.
