

**VILLAGE OF TOBACCOVILLE  
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES**

**Thursday, June 2, 2016 - 7 p.m.**

**CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Billy McHone called the meeting to order and gave the invocation. The following elected officials and staff were present: Mayor Billy McHone, Mayor Pro Tem Myron Marion, Council Members Wayne Dodson, Joyce McGee and Lori Shore-Smith, Attorney Elliot Fus, Administrator Dan Corder, and Clerk Robin Key. No one represented the press. Total attendance: 18

**RESIGNATION**

Council Member Wayne Dodson resigned his seat effective May 25, 2016 as he no longer lives in the municipal limits of the Village of Tobaccoville. (Resignation speech attached) Mayor McHone and the Council thanked him for his service to the Village.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Mayor Pro Tem Marion made a motion to approve the May 5, 2016 Council Meeting Minutes. Council Member Shore-Smith seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous. (Attachment)

**ADMINISTRATOR'S UPDATE**

Administrator Corder reminded the Council and citizens of the primary election scheduled for Tuesday, June 7, 2016. He announced the tennis courts are in the process of being repaired and will be closed indefinitely.

**PARC UPDATE**

Chairman Becky Dodson advised the Council of the *Movie in the Park* scheduled for Friday, June 3, 2016. She said the PARC is busy finalizing plans for the 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration scheduled for Saturday, September 10, 2016. (May PARC Minutes attached)

**APRIL FINANCIAL REPORT**

Administrator Corder reviewed the April financial report. Mayor Pro Tem Marion conducted an internal audit of the records and found no discrepancies. (Attachments)

**CONSIDERATION OF BUDGET FOR FISCAL 2016-2017**

Council Member McGee made a motion to open the budget hearing for consideration of the Budget for the Village of Tobaccoville for Fiscal 2016-2017. Council Member Shore-Smith seconded. The vote was unanimous. No one spoke for or against the budget. Mayor Pro Tem Marion made a motion to close the budget hearing. Council Member McGee seconded. The vote was unanimous. Mayor Pro Tem Marion made a motion to adopt Budget Ordinance #157 Budget for Fiscal 2016-2017. Council Member McGee seconded. The vote was taken as follows: Voting *yes*: Mayor Pro Tem Marion, Council Member McGee, and Council Member Shore-Smith. Voting *no*: Mayor Billy McHone. The budget was adopted by a majority vote. (Budget for Fiscal 2016-2017 & Ordinance #157 attached)

**FORSYTH COUNTY MAP FORSYTH STREET NAMING AND ADDRESS REQUEST**

A new department has been created to handle street naming and addresses in Forsyth County, and this service will no longer be covered by our interlocal agreement. A proposal to adopt an ordinance giving the new department the authority to operate within the municipal limits of the Village of Tobacoville was discussed. A second option would be to amend the existing interlocal agreement to cover the service. Joseph Sloop, Stacy Tolbert and Matt Hamby from the newly formed department addressed the Council. As soon as additional information is available, Ms. Tolbert said she will forward it to Administrator Corder.

Mayor Pro Tem Marion made a motion to accept Council Member Wayne Dodson's resignation. Council Member Shore-Smith seconded. The vote was unanimous.

**ADJOURNMENT**

Mayor Pro Tem Marion made a motion to adjourn. Council Member McGee seconded. The meeting adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
