CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Keith Snow called the meeting to order and gave the invocation. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The Village of Tobacoville would like enter into an agreement with Forsyth County to administer the program, but a Village ordinance referring to the county ordinance must be approved prior to any agreement. SPEED LIMIT ORDINANCE #127 (TOBACCOVILLE ROAD)

Council Member Beck made a motion to adopt Ordinance #127 which lowers the speed limit of Tobacoville Road from Ridge Road to the intersection of Doral Drive and Tobacoville Road. Council Member Baker seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous. (Attachment)
