

**Minutes**  
**Park and Recreation Committee**  
**June 9, 2009**

**Call to Order:** Chairperson Bill Benbow called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

**Administrator's Report:** Administrator Dan Corder gave PARC members a copy of the 2009-2010 Budget, which was adopted by the Village Council this past Thursday, June 4, 2009.
