

**Minutes
Park and Recreation Committee
July 10, 2018**

Call to Order: Administrator Dan Corder called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m. The Committee then recognized Mr. Corder for his upcoming birthday.

Members Present: Councilor Lee Ault, Traci Canter, Village Administrator Dan Corder, Carla Hall, Barbara Manuel, Kathy Sue Pyrtle, and Pamela Shehan. Nathan Ward, a local resident was also present.

Invocation: Councilor Lee Ault gave the invocation.

Approval of Minutes: A motion was made to approve the PARC Minutes for June 5, 2018 by Kathy Pyrtle and seconded by Traci Canter. The motion was approved unanimously.

Additions or Deletions to the Agenda: No additions or deletions were made.

Agenda Items:

Movies in the Park: The Committee discussed the July 20th Movie in the Park event. Flyers promoting the event were distributed to the members for posting. A Higher Bounce is scheduled for the screen/projector. The rain date is Saturday, July 21st. The movie will start at 9:00 p.m. PARC members should arrive by 7:30 p.m. to help set up tables and get popcorn machines started. Refreshments and other supplies have been bought and are ready. The date for the third movie event is September 14th and the rain date is September 15th. The Committee decided to book the movie "I Can Only Imagine" for the September movie event.

Reschedule of Music in the Park Event : The Music in the Park event has been rescheduled for October 6th with the music group "June Rise". The event will take place from 3-6 p.m. There is no rain date for this event. The Committee brought up the idea of having a chicken stew that afternoon, but someone would have to be found to do this. Old Richmond Fire Department will be contacted to see if they might want to do a fund raiser for this event. With the difficulty of the permitting process, it would be much easier to schedule food trucks. The good thing is that we have time now to get these scheduled and are not in a time crunch to do so. Various food truck vendors were discussed, including the ones that were invited to the last event which was cancelled due to weather.
