

**VILLAGE OF TOBACCOVILLE**  
**EMERGENCY CALLED MEETING MINUTES**  
**Friday, September 14, 2018 - 3 p.m.**

Mayor Mark Baker called the meeting to order. The following elected officials and staff were present: Mayor Mark Baker, Mayor Pro Tem Myron Marion, Council Members Lee Ault, Boyce Shore and Lori Shore-Smith, Administrator Dan Corder, and Clerk Robin Key. Total attendance: 8

Mayor Baker stated the purpose of the meeting was to approve a consent to the Forsyth County Declaration of a State of Emergency. (Forsyth County *Declaration of a State of Emergency* is attached.) The Tobacconville Consent to the Forsyth County Declaration allows the State of Emergency to apply within the municipal limits of Tobacconville. Council Member Boyce Shore made a motion to adopt the Consent to the Forsyth County Declaration and authorized Mayor Mark Baker to rescind the consent, when necessary. Mayor Pro Tem Marion seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous. (*Consent to Application of County State of Emergency Declaration* is attached.)
