

**VILLAGE OF TOBACCOVILLE
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
Thursday, June 4, 2020**

Due to the threat of spreading the COVID-19 virus, the June Council meeting was conducted in Village Hall and through remote conference call access facilitated by Attorney Amy Lanning. Mayor Mark Baker called the meeting to order at 7 p.m. and turned the meeting over to Attorney Lanning who established protocol for the meeting. The following elected officials and staff members joined the meeting at Village Hall: Mayor Mark Baker, Mayor Pro Tem Myron Marion, Council Members Lee Ault, Boyce Shore, and Lori Shore-Smith, Administrator Corder and Clerk Robin Key. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Council Member Shore-Smith made a motion to approve the May 7, 2020 Council Meeting Minutes. Mayor Pro Tem Marion seconded. The vote was unanimous.

ADMINISTRATOR'S UPDATE

Administrator Corder updated the Council on the paving projects in the Village, the grant process with McGill Associates and grant monies available from the Corona Virus Relief Fund.

PUBLIC COMMENT TIME

Kurt Feldmeyer, Crisis Response Chaplain for the Village of Tobaccoville, emailed an update detailing his activities in the field during the month of May.

PRESENTATION OF BUDGET FOR FISCAL 2020-2021

Administrator Corder presented the Budget for Fiscal 2020-2021 and answered questions from the Council. Council Member Shore made a motion to open a public hearing for the discussion of the Budget for Fiscal 2020-2021. Council Member Shore-Smith seconded. No one spoke for or against the budget. Council Member Shore made a motion to close the public hearing. Council Member Ault seconded. Council Member Shore-Smith made a motion to adopt Budget Ordinance #176 *Budget for Fiscal 2020-2021 for the Village of Tobaccoville*. Mayor Pro Tem Marion seconded. APRIL FINANCIAL REPORT

TAX COLLECTION ORDINANCES

Council Member Shore-Smith made a motion to adopt Tax Collection Ordinance #177 empowering Forsyth County to collect back taxes for the Village of Tobaccoville and Tax Collection Ordinance #178 empowering Forsyth County to collect 2020 taxes for the Village of Tobaccoville. Council Member Ault seconded. The vote was unanimous. (Attachments)
