SPECIAL CALLED COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
JUNE 21, 2021

The Village Council met at 8:00 a.m. on June 21, 2021 in the Conference Room of Village Hall.

The following elected officials and staff members joined the meeting at Village Hall: Mayor Mark Baker, Mayor Pro Tem Myron Marion, Council Members Lee Ault, Boyce Shore and Lori Shore-Smith, Administrator Dan Corder, and Attorney Bowen Houff.

Mayor Mark Baker opened the meeting. Mayor Baker then made a motion to go in to closed session per N.C. General Statue 143-318.11(a)(3) to consult with an attorney employed or retained by the public body in order to preserve the attorney-client privilege between the public body, which privilege is hereby acknowledged, and 143-318.11(a)(6) to consider the qualifications, competence, performance, character, fitness, conditions of appointment, or conditions of initial employment of an individual public officer or employee or prospective public officer or employee; or to hear or investigate a complaint, charge, or grievance by or against an individual public officer or employee. Council Member Boyce Shore seconded the motion and the Council voted unanimously to go to closed session.

During the closed session, the Council debated a personnel matter and conferred with the Village Attorney regarding such.

The Council returned from closed session to regular session at 9:31 a.m.

Council Member Lori Shore-Smith made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Council Member Lee Ault seconded the motion. All voted in favor of the motion and the meeting adjourned at 9:32 a.m.
