

**VILLAGE OF TOBACCOVILLE  
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
Thursday, June 3, 2021**

Mayor Mark Baker called the meeting to order at 7 p.m. and Council Member Boyce Shore gave the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance. The following elected officials and staff were present: Mayor Mark Baker, Mayor Pro Tem Myron Marion, Council Members Lee Ault, Boyce Shore and Lori Shore-Smith, Attorney Amy Lanning, Administrator Dan Corder and Clerk Robin Key. Total attendance: 10

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Council Member Shore requested a correction be made to the May 6, 2021 Budget Workshop Minutes to indicate he was in attendance. Council Member Shore-Smith made a motion to approve the May 6, 2021 Budget Workshop Minutes as amended and the May 6, 2021 Council Meeting Minutes. Mayor Pro Tem Marion seconded. The vote was unanimous.

**ADMINISTRATOR'S UPDATE**

Bulk Pick-Up was successfully completed at a cost of \$7,315. The gazebo roof was replaced today, and the parking lot project should begin sometime later this month. There was a consensus of the Council to begin taking more than one weekend rental in the community center. Mayor Baker advised the Council on the latest information regarding ARP funding and acceptable uses for the funds, which should be distributed later in the month. There was a consensus of the Council for Administrator Corder to contact the former members of the Park & Recreation Committee (PARC) for their interest in participating in the committee to plan movies in the park for possibly August and September. Administrator Corder advised the Council that a PARC Chairman should be in place before re-establishment. New members will also be recruited from the Village website and Facebook page.

**APRIL FINANCIAL REPORT**

Administrator Corder reviewed the April financial report. Mayor Pro Tem Marion conducted an internal audit of the records and found no discrepancies. (Attachments)

**VILLAGE OF TOBACCOVILLE BUDGET FOR FISCAL 2021-2022**

Council Member Shore made a motion to open a budget hearing for discussion of the Budget for Fiscal 2021-2022. Mayor Pro Tem Marion seconded. The vote was unanimous. No one spoke for or against the Budget. Council Member Shore-Smith made a motion to close the budget hearing and Council Member Ault seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous. Council Member Shore made a motion to adopt Budget Ordinance #181 *Budget for Fiscal 2021-2022*. Council Member Shore-Smith seconded. The vote was unanimous. (Attachments)

**TAX COLLECTION ORDINANCES**

In order to enter a contract with the Forsyth County Tax Department for the collection of taxes for the Village of Tobacoville, Council Member Shore-Smith made a motion to adopt Ordinance #182 for the collection of back taxes and Ordinance #183 for the collection of 2021 taxes. Mayor Pro Tem Marion seconded the motion, and the vote was unanimous. (Attachments)

Council Member Shore made a motion to adjourn, and Council Member Shore-Smith seconded. The meeting adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
