

**VILLAGE OF TOBACCOVILLE
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
Thursday, January 6, 2022**

Mayor Myron Marion called the meeting to order at 7 p.m. and gave the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance. The following elected officials and staff were present: Mayor Myron Marion, Council Members Mark Baker and Boyce Shore, Administrator Dan Corder, Attorney Amy Lanning, Clerk Robin Key and Kimberly Keen. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Council Member Mark Baker made a motion to approve the December 2, 2021 Council Meeting Minutes. Mayor Myron Marion seconded. The vote was unanimous.

ADMINISTRATOR'S UPDATE

- *Administrator Corder advised that Christmas decorations will be removed January 12, 2022.
- *The PARC Committee met prior to the Council Meeting at 6 p.m. Council Member Mark Baker said they are seeking additional members. Future event dates were discussed and more information will follow.
- *Several Village Hall parking lot light globes were damaged during the wind storm earlier in the week and a quote will be sought for replacements. If affordable, all globes in Village Hall parking lot will be replaced
- *Love's Truck Stop zoning request goes to Forsyth County Commissioners soon.
- *Forsyth County Manager, Dudley Watts, is planning a series of public meetings (possibly beginning in March) in The Village of Tobaccoville to receive input on the proposed land development of Forsyth County property that is accessed by Doral Drive. The Village Council will be briefed in February prior to the public meetings in March.
- *ARP (American Rescue Plan) Funds guidelines for use of funds were updated by the US Government and funds may be used as revenue replacement. The Council will make plans at future meetings as to how the funds will be utilized.
