

**VILLAGE OF TOBACCOVILLE
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
Thursday, August 4, 2022**

Mayor Myron Marion called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Myron Marion gave the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance. The following elected officials and staff were present: Mayor Myron Marion, Council Members Mark Baker, Carla Hall and Boyce Shore, Attorney Amy Lanning, Administrator Dan Corder, and Clerk Kimberly L. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Council Member Boyce Shore made a motion to approve the July 7, 2022 Council Meeting Minutes. Council Member Mark Baker seconded. The vote was unanimous in favor of the motion.

ADMINISTRATOR'S UPDATE

Administrator Dan Corder advised that the final payment of the ARPA funds should be received any day and will be transferred to the ARP Restricted bank account upon receipt. Administrator Dan Corder also reminded the Council that the link for Ethics Training had been forwarded to them and should be completed by September 30th. Administration Dan Corder informed Council that the contract with the NCDOT had been corrected as instructed and executed. This contact will use Powell Bill funds to pave the Meadows Subdivision, Snyder Farm Road and Belgrove Drive.

MONTHLY FINANCIAL REPORT

Administrator Dan Corder reviewed the June financial report. Mayor Myron Marion conducted an internal audit of the records and found no discrepancies. (attachments)

PARC UPDATE

- Face painting and six inflatables
- Car & Tractor Show
- Forsyth County Sheriff's Department and Old Richmond Fire Department
- Door prizes every 30 minutes as well as free gifts for everyone in attendance (attachments)
