

## **PARC (Park & Recreation Committee) MINUTES**

**JUNE 4, 2026**

**6:00PM**

In attendance were Mayor Mark Baker (in the absence of Chris Copeland and Jennifer Stone), Kim Baker, Leanne Gay, Angela Williams, Ed and Dianne Schwander and Administrator Lori Shore.

Mayor Mark Baker opened the meeting at 6:03pm and updated the PARC members on the upcoming events in the Village: June 12<sup>th</sup> Movie in the Park, (Lilo & Stitch) being shown at dusk and asked members to arrive early to start popcorn and serve refreshments, July 3<sup>rd</sup> US Army Band event at 6:00pm, August 7<sup>th</sup> Movie in the Park (Superman) being shown at dusk with members needing to arrive early to start popcorn and serve refreshments and a discussion was held about the 35<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration which will take place on Saturday, September 19<sup>th</sup> from 12-4pm.

Lori will pick up sodas, water and candy for the Movie Nights.

At the Anniversary Celebration we will have an Auto Tractor Show which will take place on the baseball field, Slate Myers who is the youngest winner at Bowman Gray will bring his racecar which will be parked on the baseball field as well. Kim Baker informed the members that she has around 40 Vendor applications at this time and will be accepting Vendor applications up until August 14<sup>th</sup>. One church has sent in their interest, which is Old Richmond Evangelical. We will have Taylor Vaden doing his Elvis Show at the Amphitheater and the Forsyth County Sheriff's Office K9 Unit will do a demonstration during the break. We will have two FCSO deputies at the park during the event. Discussion was held about finding face painters and a clown to make balloon animals and Leanne will check into that. The members discussed asking for donations from local businesses for door prizes and Lori stated that she will speak with the owners of Little Italy and Cup of Joe to see if they would donate gift certificates and the Village will donate a rental. The Village will set up a table to give out door prize tickets. We will also have 3 prizes for the top 3 auto/tractor show participants. Lori will check on prices for giveaways, like t-shirts, hats, etc. and the Village will sell those along with our license plates. Mark is going to call Daniel Motsinger to see if he would be willing to bring his golf car to help during the event and is going to contact someone about a train to haul kids around on during the event and then we will have to see if our insurance will allow/cover it.

We will have 8 Port-a-jons and 3 handwashing stations delivered from New Life II Septic Co.
